The worldwide pandemic, Covid left a deep scar on the cinema industry like everywhere else. The industry went through a terrible struggle during the lockdown times and after. But this did not affect good films being produced in any way. 2021-22 saw a surge of great films being made despite the hurdles we faced. The 26th IFFK selected seven films into the 'Indian Cinema Now' category from over 200 submissions. Most of these films were great but unfortunately some



had to be eliminated. It was a pleasure to watch films exploring topics like the depth and intensity of relationships, human bonding and isolation. Also, the fact that there are a number of films being made in unknown languages, tribal languages and on a variety of new and interesting themes and ideologies has to be emphasized. The last year saw cinema in a new light, alight with the glory of survival and hope, and a promising future in the cinema industry. Baagh, Boomba Ride, Deep6, Into the Mist, Life is Suffering Death is Salvation, Shoebox and The Brittle Thread are the seven films that are screened in this category.



The 26th International Film Festival of Kerala launched a three-day Malayalam Cinema Symposium. Producers and directors participated in the programme, discussing the topic 'OTT Platforms & New Exhibition Possibilities for Malayalam Cinema'. The distinguished panel was of the opinion that OTT platforms will bring more opportunities to filmmakers. This is obvious from the fact that more producers opt for OTT releases.

Sangeetha Janachandran had the opinion that OTT platforms are more 'content driven, and not star driven'. Producer G. Suresh Kumar said that producers opt for OTT platforms as a safe option, and it provides them with financial security. Actor and producer Vijay Babu viewed cinemas and OTT platforms as a co-existing supporting system to each other. He added to it that contrary to popular belief, OTT platforms do not employ middlemen. Day one of the symposium, which was held at Hotel Apollo Dimora, ended with a Q&A session. KSCA Chairman Ranjith, filmmaker Shyamaprasad and Svetlana Naudiyal, Programming Head, MUBI, India were present in the discussion.

# A Note on South Indian Cinema

Dr. Ajay S. Sekher

The South Indian and Kerala films are now showing a remarkable sense of reality, after spells of amnesia and evasions. There is hope in this transition. As cultural critic and film theorist of the oppositional gaze, bell hooks, who passed away recently, observed that the people are watching cinema and there is a power in the gaze that is enabling. The films from the South address crucial human and ecological issues in myriad ways

now. In Avanovilona by Sherry Govind and Deepesh T, the trans people and sexworkers are juxtaposed with religious minorities and the history of evangelism in Kerala in precarious and paradoxical ways. Kannada films like Pedro that make an artful difference falls back to the stale aesthetics of reiterative or Sanatana status quo and a consensual sort of apology for exclusions and violent erasures or genocide while appropriating and monopolizing speech and the critical representations on caste and its killing rage in India.

The potentials and possibilities of a new South Indian cinema of survival in centralised repressive times are imminent as the mainstream commercial cinema itself is showing new liberative trends of addressing the graded inequality in multiple ways as in new Tamil cinema. Kevin Joseph's murder for an inter faith marriage and many other hegemonic realities of the present are now being bravely represented on the silver screen in hit movies across Kerala. The complicit role of academia, media and cultural institutions of the state must also be critically represented in film in hindsight and farsightednesses in democratic and enabling ways.
